Berkeley Township Housing Inspection Requirements For Residential Properties-Resale or Rental

Interior

- Potable approved water supply
- Toilet, tub, & shower afford privacy
- Plumbing fixtures in good working order
- Hot & Cold water to sinks & tubs
- Heating equipment properly installed & in working order
- Mandatory smoke detectors & carbon monoxide detectors within 10 feet of sleeping area
- Egress safe and unobstructed
- Floors, foundation, walls, ceilings, doors, windows (clean & in good working order)
- 3 or more steps must have handrail
- Foundation, floors, walls free of dampness
- Free of rodents
- Window screens from May 1 to October 1
- Paint/Wallpaper in good condition
- Kitchen/Bathroom floors impervious to water
- Termite report may be required
- Solid core door or sheathing on door from garage to house
- No extension cords, sliced cords or adapter outlet for garage door openers
- Entrance Door Deadbolt lock must not require a key to exit house or apartment

Exterior

- Trash properly stored in approved containers
- Windows, roof & other parts of building in good repair
- Decks, porches, balcony have safe railings
- Roof, walls, windows, exterior doors free from holes & leaks
- Premises free from litter, garbage, rubbish, junk & debris
- Lawns, hedges, bushes are to be maintained & trimmed
- Fences in good repair
- Driveway, steps sidewalks are to be in good repair
- Gutters & downspouts are to be in good repair
- Street numbers on home must be visible from roadway
- Pool fencing to meet code from original installation
- Sheds, garages are to be in good repair
- Bulkheads are to be in good repair

Other Requirements

- Well water must have a Certification for OCHD if primary source of water
- If oil supplied, must have tank tested for leak & certified by company that tested tank
- Property in a Flood Zone must supply the Township with current Flood Elevation Certificate with raised seal
- All open permits must be closed before the Certificate of Occupancy can be issued
- Property owner or a representative must be on site to operate all utilities

Fire Extinguishers

Berkeley Township Requirements for all resale & rental properties

- 1. Rated ABC Type 2A:10B:C
- 2. Must be mounted and visible within 10 feet of the kitchen. Fire extinguisher can't be blocked by furniture, storage or other items, and cannot be placed inside enclosed areas. It must be accompanied by an owner's manual.
- 3. The top of the fire extinguisher cannot be higher than five (5) feet above the floor.
- 4. Fire extinguisher must be near a room exit or travel way that provides an escape route to the exterior.
